AASA Learning 2025 Network Happenings for the Week of May 15, 2024

The Grable Foundation, Remake Learning, and AASA invited the nation’s top educational thinkers and school district leaders to participate in Forge Futures for Youth, Educators, and Families: A National Summit on Community-Wide Learning held May 8-9, 2024 in Pittsburgh, PA. Nearly 300 attendees participated in two days of active learning and collective action to make learning more engaging, relevant, and equitable for young people. The Summit included site visits, networking, problem solving, and collaborative planning experiences.



To kick off the Summit, more than 70 of AASA’s Learning 2025 school districts and members of the Global Education Leaders’ Partnership were invited to attend special professional development sessions on school/district transformation and reimagining learning on May 7. This pre-convening was organized and led by AASA, Grable Foundation, Remake Learning, and Digital Promise.

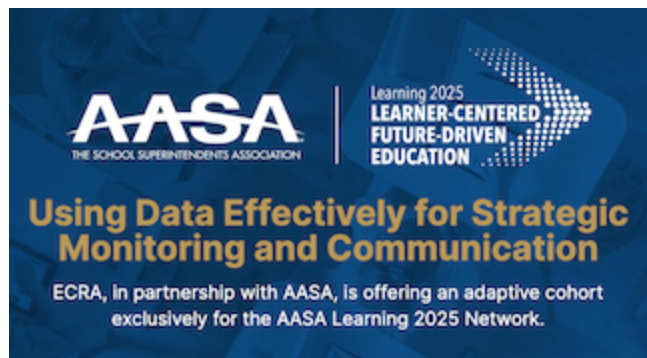
