At the conclusion of the 2019 NLC I had an opportunity to visit with several state leaders that attended this year's conference. The state leaders had a few recommendations for refining the conference and I wanted to share their thoughts for consideration. The goal of this proposal is to reduce NAESP expenses, eliminate the current \$100 registration fee, save membership time out of our buildings, and improve the amount of time our office spends focusing on state representatives. Due to the current conference structure, some states are considering sending their delegation out on Monday to eliminate one day of expenses to their state organization.
