# **Items for Discussion**

#### 1. <u>MASSP Board of Directors Update</u> – *Joel*

Joel stated that the with Paul Culbertson's resignation, Jacob Haynes was appointed as MASSP Vice President. He added that it is important that the Board Members continue to talk to other MASSP members about running for offices. Pat will open the Vice President vacancy for next year the end of February.

# 2. <u>MASSP Delegate Selection</u> – Joel

Joel stated that MASSP will have ten delegates for Delegate Assembly. Kirk stated that the SAM Regional Map is what is used for Delegate Assembly. Two delegates should be appointed from each region. Paul Furthmyre, the steering committee member, is from Region II so only one additional member from that region is needed. Justin has spoken to a few members from Region III that may be interested. Joel would like to see members from all regions get involved. Joel asked that the Directors send names of interested members to Kirk or himself. Kirk added that two or three alternates are also needed so MASSP is fully represented at Delegate Assembly. Members cannot be added after June 7, 2018 - one week before Delegate Assembly.

Pat explained the META Website Accessibility Project, the METAhelp.org website, and ADA compliance for school district websites. Pat pointed out the RANCH Rules link on the METAhelp.org website and also the text box at the bottom the website for users to submit questions and comments.

  - Adding a link and bolding words was also explained within posting a message
  - Kim pointed out that you can go in and post a new topic at anytime within the same forum
  - Kirk pointed out that you will not receive a bundle of emails when you use this vs the E-list
  - Kim pointed out that when you get an email notification when subscribed to a forum, the body of the message is included.
  - Kim also pointed out that you can go to technical help and ask a question
