- 3. Montana Assistant Principal of the Year Deadline Extended to Oct 15th
 - a. How do you encourage your colleagues/community to nominate for awards?
 - Shawnda encouraged all administrators to nominate a deserving candidate and to spread the word.
- 4. MCEL 2021: Oct 20-22 Virtual conference: Shawnda reminded about the conference to the group. Also reminded them that it is virtual this year.
- 5. Teacher/Staff Shortages:
 - a. What are you still missing from your school/district?
 - i. Joliet is missing a math teacher
 - ii. Laurel HS still missing Math and History
 - iii. Laurel MS still missing FACS teacher
 - iv. Others filled most of their openings.
 - v. Lots of Aide positions open, custodians, bus drivers
 - b. Are any of you having difficulties with sub shortages? Most schools are reporting significant shortages in subs
 - i. What are some strategies you are using to cover classes?
 - Paying teachers an extra period of pay if they cover. Most districts report this has helped immensely. Many districts are using ESSR funds to help. Reduction in class sizes.
 - Using aides to cover, calling it a Math Lab in collaboration with Math teacher support to continue learning momentum. Has been very successful.
 - Move classes to study hall area where aides cover the class in a larger setting and access learning materials through google classroom.
 - ii. One question that came up is for the TEAMS report and if there will be any grace due to the licensing departments long delays with applications?
 - iii. The discussion also came up with the concerns about OPI and teacher licensure taking so long.
 - iv. Additionally the group discussed the interesting uptick in applicants from the Philippines for teaching positions.
 - 1. Some concerns shared: translation to licensure
 - 2. Language barrier: It was shared that English is a first language
 - 3. Visa sponsorship: How does that work for a district?
 - 4. Shelby Public Schools hired several teachers from this country: there is a cultural aspect to this, if there is more than one teacher from the Philippines the likelihood of success goes up versus if it is a lone teacher from the Philippines.
 - 5. It is a full time job to support foreign teachers.
