- FY2023 Part B IDEA Grant Application is open for public comment as of 3/19 4/21. All Public Comments will be taken into consideration and may be directed to jp.williams@mt.gov
 - a. JP did the annual application for this year. Required to add in GAPA Section 24 form-4 questions talking about equity. All Districts and CoOps are required to submit. Sara N. has submitted around recruitment.
 - b. USDOE-do not have the allocations yet so these have not been sent out. Congress has not sent out budgets yet. Biden has proposed a significant increase.

- c. JP will put out the budget
- d. District will see an increase in allocations in the preliminary and when finals are done-another increase. Possible supplemental flow through. You will see last year's budget currently on the webpage.
- 3. MCASE/SAM Update Sara Novak-Summarized in an email from Jenny.
 - a. SAM renewed contracts for SAM office
 - i. Rob offered no increase in salary and advocated for an increase for office staff as they help us with lots of conference support.
 - b. MCASE Board Meeting June 9, 2023, delegate assembly meeting in Helena
 - i. Same time as the Delegate Assembly. Encouraging many people to attend this.
 - c. People are signing up to become involved in MCASE office positions
 - i. Winners for next election cycles will be coming.
 - ii. Need for Regional representatives.
 - d. Recruitment Project Director Vacancy is posted.
 - e. Still Legislative actions. Emails from different folks on updates.
- 4. Program Narrative- Participating districts do not need to sign approval, but approval needs to be through one approval Board.
 - a. Program Narratives should be updated every 5 years
 - i. Not filed with the Secretary of State
 - ii. Lots are outdated-in the process of updating
 - iii. Need Districts to submit to Dani with Board approval
 - iv. If you need to know what the last one submitted, please contact Dani
 - v. No signatures needed but the Board needs to know
 - vi. Lots of Superintendents and Sped Directors are not aware they need to do this
 - vii. Dani has them all. Need the letter that says approved by OPI. Send Program Narratives to Dani in a draft form so she can send revisions and then get Board approval. Proof of Board approval-take the Sped Director's word of Board approval.
 - viii. ARM on Program Narratives: https://rules.mt.gov/gateway/RuleNo.asp?RN=10%2E16%2E3220
 - ix. Need to update if new policy on student attendance up to age 21 years old.
 - x. Program Narratives may come up in the Audits.
 - xi. ARM-Districts and CoOps are stated in this rule. CoOps-completed by CoOp Director and all sped District policies and procedures attached-child find, collect, maintain and report child find pk-12, private schools.
 - b. Interlocals every 3 years need to be updated-Send to JP
 - i. What do you do if schools refuse to sign
 - 1. This is a problem. Send to JP and Dani. OPI will send a letter for action needed. Talk to accreditation who will refer to the Board of Education for further action.
 - ii. Amendments need to be filed with the Secretary of State and all counties

iii. Interlocal Purpose: (a) The districts desire to offer full services to persons requiring special education (said persons defined in 20-7-401, MCA) and to all children within said districts.

b) The districts desire to provide these special education services in compliance with all applicable State and Federal laws, regulations, and accreditation standards.

(c) Establish a full service cooperative to perform all education administrative services, activities, and undertakings it is authorized to perform according to 20-7-451 through 20-7-456, MCA

***Please check with JP as to the needed process. Signature will be needed. This is a process and will take time to review and provide feedback. Dani is willing to support as well.

- 5. Grants for Summer Institute & national conference Danni
 - a. Additional funds available that would need to be expended by September 30th.
 - b. Discretionary grant for special education directors and staff to attend the summer institute (June 19-23rd in Bozeman)
 - c. Any National Conference (before September 1st) could be covered as well.
- 6. A student who needs to be reevaluated-VI. Lots of medical needs-lots of heat on reevaluation from the doctor and parent to get speech and ABA 5 days a week in the school environment. Lots of medical information with doctor statements that the student is functioning as a 1 year old. What are you using to evaluate a severe and profound?
 - a. Developmental history, review medical reports/diagnosis, review of data, if the child is untestable-the review of data is the best tool
 - b. Oregon Survey-child engaged, observation
 - c. Kerri Norick offered this assessment
 - d. Functionally what is she able to do? Non verbal, sleeps a lots, behaviors, seizures have declined her ability to function,
 - e. Every Move Counts -<u>https://www.everymovecounts.net/index.html</u>
 - f. Contract with a nurse to summarize all the medical reports/diagnoses and include in the ER for the team to consider educational implications.
 - g. Drafted letter to Family Outreach in regard to the psychological assessment results are included in the Evaluation Report and not a separate report. Lani has a drafted letter she provided to Lisa Loken at Family Outreach for 0208 waiver applications. If the student is untestable, Family Outreach will accept this documentation too.
