I am currently working with Arrowhead School and beginning to work with Cooke City. I am looking for additional options to continue to expand. We know from the research that students perform better academically when provided with social emotional programs. Many teachers do not believe that they have the necessary skills to meet their students' mental-health needs. Without the proper training and guidance to accommodate students with conditions like ADHD, anxiety, and behavioral problems, teachers are more likely to experience additional stress on the job. I am hoping to be able to help fill this much needed gap, by coming into classrooms and providing social emotional curriculum that is tailored to the needs of each school.
