A personalized approach to professional development

Envision and design a plan

During our Design Kickoffs, teachers name and prioritize their most pressing classroom challenges and design a plan to address them. Teachers leave with a tangible work product and immediately actionable next steps.

Implement plan with coach support

We match each teacher with an expert coach to support the plan's implementation In bi-weekly, virtual meetings, teachers discuss student successes and pitfalls while coaches leverage their experience to suggest alterantive applications and new strategies.

Track progress and reflect

As teachers work through their plans, progress is tracked in our digital app. The app records strategies tried, students impacted, teacher reflections and any uploaded artifacts of student work. It then aggregates the information into a comprehensive, online portfolio.
